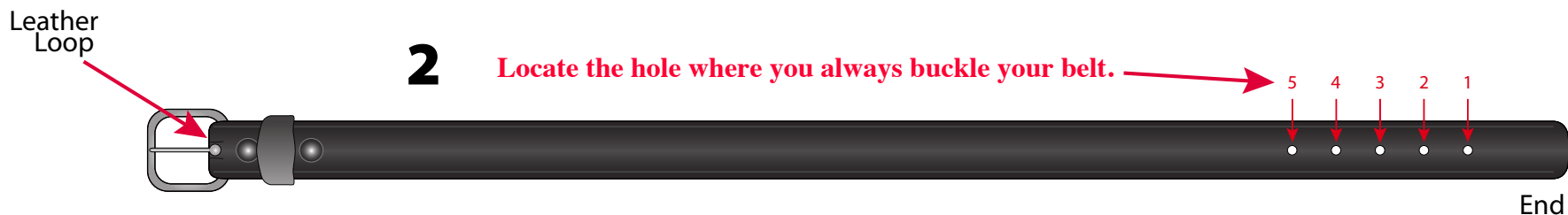


THIS IS AN EXAMPLE OF HOW TO MEASURE YOUR OLD BELT TO GET THE SIZE YOU NEED TO ORDER YOUR NEW BELT.

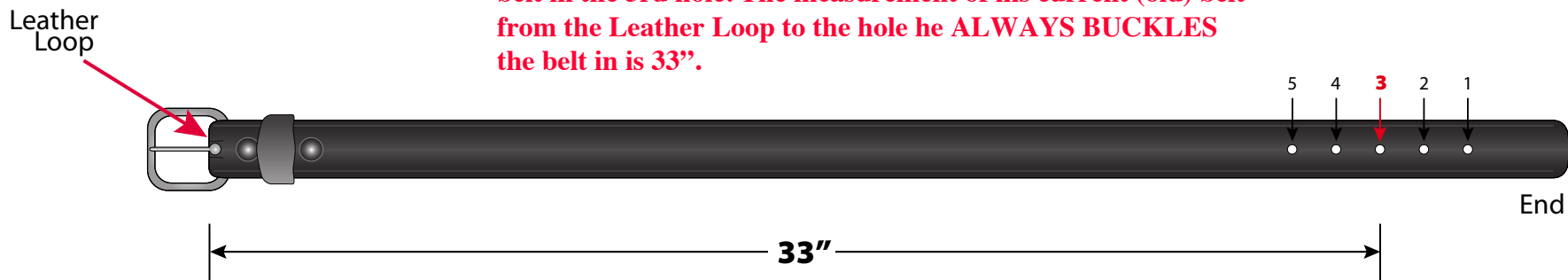
1 Lay the belt on a table or flat surface.



2 Locate the hole where you always buckle your belt.



3 Example:
The person who wears this belt ALWAYS BUCKLES his old belt in the 3rd hole. The measurement of his current (old) belt from the Leather Loop to the hole he ALWAYS BUCKLES the belt in is 33".



In this example, either a 32 inch or a 34 inch NEW Belt would be orderd.

(Always use EVEN numbers when specifying the length of your NEW Belt.)

*** The Length of the NEW Belt you order will vary depending upon which Hole is the one you ALWAYS BUCKLE with your CURRENT (Old) belt and the distance from that hole to the Leather Loop.**
